

Standard Description of the Rhinelander Canary_

Head and Crest: The crest must be in the shape of a horse-shoe. The crest extends forward from above the eyes. The crest must be symmetrical from its commencement in the center of the head.

The transition of the crest to the nape/neck must be smooth-feathered (close-fitting) without any trace of a crest.

The "plain head" has a proportionately large head, slightly rounded and showing eyebrows. Grizzled and dark crests

are allowed.....20 pts

Body: Slim and elegant. The breast and the back are slightly rounded.....20 pts

Position: Erect, the back is slightly rounded.....20 pts

Size: Not to be in excess of 12 cm. (4.7 in).....15 pts

Plumage: Smooth and close-fitting to the body.....10 pts

Legs: Legs are fine, delicate and slightly flexed. The thighs are just visible.....5 pts

Tail: Well folded and slightly forked.....5 pts

Condition: In a good health and clean. Uniform colour, yellow, red and white, buff and intensive.

No variegation is allowed except in the crest.....5 pts

TOTAL = 100 points

SHOW CAGE: Tunnel type show cage with 2 round perches 12 mm in diameter (1 above and 1 below).
